It is an honor to serve those who serve.



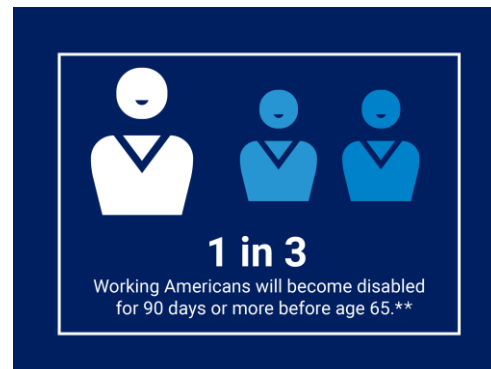

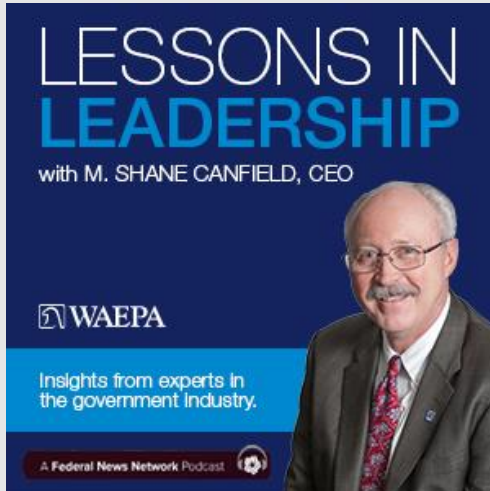
